



Boulder Creek Wildfire Update

- **The fire continues to burn and is estimated at 5, 361 ha**
- **We are cooperating proactively with the BC Wildfire Service and the Squamish Lillooet Regional District**
- **The evacuation order is still in effect and the Lillooet River FSR is closed at KM 9**
- **BC Wildfire Service is actively working to protect the area (sprinklers, pre-emptive burning etc.)**
- **The Wildfire Service personnel are using the camp as a base to fight the surrounding fires**
- **There is no indication yet for when it will be safe for workers to return to the Project site. Preliminary indication of work stop time is estimated at 4-6 weeks**
- **So far damages to the Project seem limited but a full site inspection has not occurred**
