## **TRAVEL NOT RECOMMENDED \*\***

KM	Activity along the Lillooet River FSR
KM 37.5	Check Point Booth is in place 24 hr/day.
KM 38.5	Tunnelling at the Boulder Creek HEF. Blasting will occur daily.
KM 39	Access road to Boulder Creek Intake. Works ongoing with blasting occurring daily.
KM 41.2	Upper Lillooet River HEF Powerhouse site open.
KM 41.8	New access road with active truck hauling in and out
KM 42	<b>Lillooet River Trail is now OPEN.</b> Temporary signage and flagging are in place to route hikers through the area.
	<b>PLEASE NOTE</b> : the trailhead is an active construction zone so please use caution in this area and refrain from parking along the FSR.
KM 42-44	Upper Lillooet River HEF Penstock works ongoing.
KM 44	Upper Lillooet River HEF Downstream Tunnel Portal site open.
KM 47-49	Upper Lillooet River HEF Intake and Upstream Tunnel Portal site open.

Road Name	Activities associated with Transmission Line (South side)
Miller Bench FSR	Seasonal deactivation beyond KM 3 and road grading from KM 0-3 to be completed November $15^{\rm th}$ .
Miller South	All works to be wrapped up by November 15 <sup>th</sup> .
