



# Project Update

## DRIVE WITH CARE

- Heavy Equipment will continue to be transported from the Pemberton Yard to the Project site (km 38).
- Clearing will commence off of the Ryan River FSR Monday June 16<sup>th</sup>

KM	Activity along the Lillooet River FSR
<b>KM 22-29</b>	Active falling and skidding along the FSR. Watch for flaggers on road.
<b>KM 37.8 - 38</b>	Construction Camp activities off of Pebble Creek Mainline Road (37.8 km). <b>Caution:</b> trucks hauling between 37.8 km (off onto Pebble Creek Mainline) and 38 km (laydown).
<b>KM 38.5</b>	Construction activities, including blasting are underway at Boulder Creek HEF Powerhouse.
<b>KM 39.8</b>	Road upgrades continuing along Athel Mainline Road.
<b>KM 41.5 – 42</b>	Construction activities underway at Upper Lillooet River HEF Powerhouse <b>Caution:</b> Logging equipment near road at 41.5 km.
<b>KM 42.5</b>	Road construction activities currently underway for the east heading of the Lillooet River FSR realignment.
<b>KM 43.5-44.5 (Hot Springs trailhead area)</b>	Traffic control measures will be implemented if required for construction activities in this area.
<b>KM 44-44.5</b>	Road construction activities currently underway for the west heading of the Lillooet River FSR realignment.
<b>KM 48</b>	Active falling and construction activities at the Upper Lillooet River HEF intake and spoil areas.

### Lillooet River FSR - general updates on other industrial users

- Ongoing maintenance along the Lillooet River FSR being conducted by Squamish Mills (primary road use permit holder), including grading, ditching and brushing.
